You will be given a friendly and experienced event coordinator to help you with any plans, decisions or concerns.



We have a range of day delegate rates, or can offer room hire only options. Whatever you need, the team will work closely with you to create the right package.



For those staying over, we can also organise accommodation; from comfy nights in University accommodation, to bed and breakfast stays at the Edgbaston Park Hotel.


